Thank you all for continuing to work in partnership with us to support our learners.

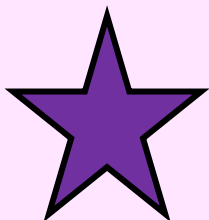
And finally, for those celebrating Eid ul-Adha on 28th and 29th June 2023, enjoy this time of prayer and visiting with your friends and family.

Pupil Voice: Cyber Security

Our learners shared their views about the risks, threats and consequences of how they would protect their personal data after watching an interactive video where the characters faced various choices. Each learner had an opportunity to make choices for the character and watched the outcome. They also discussed the meaning of hacking, social engineering and phishing. Here is a snapshot of what they said:

"I would share my password with my friends and family..." "...but what if your friend went into your account, changed your details and sent a message to someone?" Oh...I didn't think about that!"

"...I would share my live location with friends so they would know where I was."

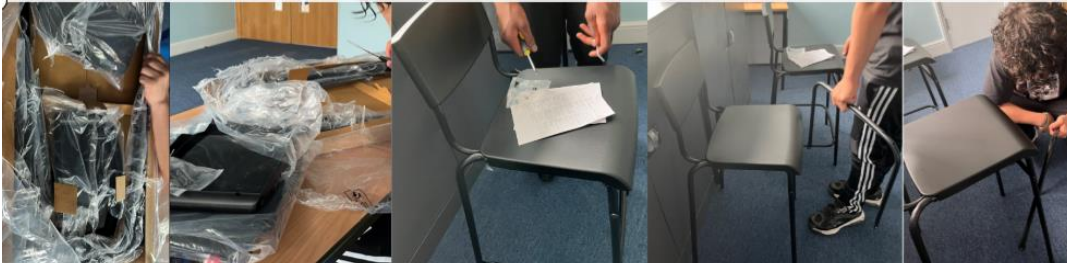
Curriculum shout out: Science/Food Technology

This month our learners had opportunities to link maths and science with food technology where they made a cheesecake!

- Measured quantities and ingredients
- Made decisions to halve quantities
- Worked collaboratively
- Discussion around food preparation and hygiene
